This document provides answers to frequently asked questions on the Newmarket Eagles Cycling Club (NECC) Masters Race Team.

What is the Race Team's Vision?

The Race Team will participate in OCA O-Cup Road, Track, Mountain, Cyclocross, Ontario Provincial and Canadian National Championships, and races outside of Southern Ontario during this upcoming 2025 race season.

Our moto is "Have fun, be safe, cycle hard, kick ass!"

What do I need to do to be part of the Race Team?

- 1. Join the Newmarket Eagles Cycling Club
- 2. Purchase an OCA license in 2025 and indicate that your team is the Newmarket Eagles Cycling Club
- 3. Race your bike
- 4. Wear your Eagles jersey and shorts
- 5. Have fun, be safe, cycle hard and kick ass

Do I need to shave my legs?

No, shaving is not required. However I would be remiss if I did not point out Rule #33 of the official rules of cycling
